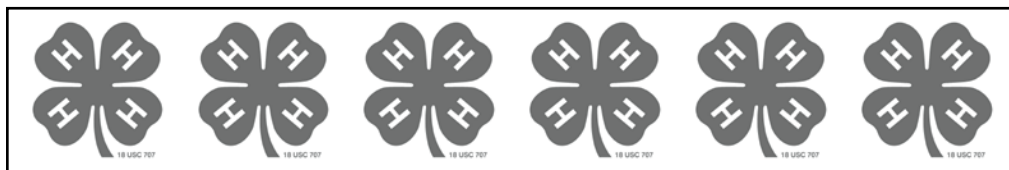

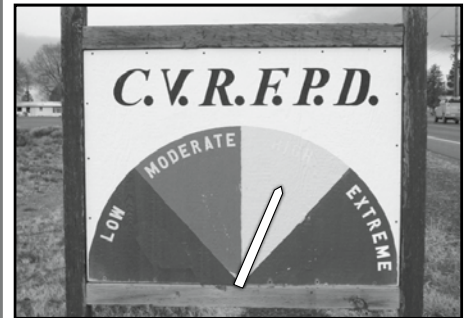

**Back in Thyme Herbals**

**THE MAGIC OF SEEDS** part 2



It has been proven that the husks of wheat seeds are valuable in nutrition. Mixing the chaff with hot water and steeping until the substances within the chaff soaked out, have made premature and underweight infants gain weight so rapidly, they soon outweighed the healthier babies. They are not quite sure just what it is about the chaff that is so miraculous, but it works.

Scientists L. A. Balabanova, B. N. Tsyurupa, Humberto Valeri, Pievo Gallo and Peter A. Ark (professor of plant pathology at University of California at Berkley) have found that seeds such as those of the privet, dog rose, white acacia, common ash, honey locust, avocado pear, wheat and barley juice, contain antibiotic as well as substances similar to penicillin.

A diuretic is prescribed for sufferers of accumulation of fluid in the body and excessive swelling due to various diseases of the kidneys, heart or lungs. Research scientist V. A. Skovronski found effective diuretics in seeds of caraway, sweet fennel and anise, that are "particularly safe because they are commonly used as spices and flavorings." According to research scientists Agarwal, Sharma, and Dandiya of the Medical College in Jaipur, India, carrot seed extract was found to depress respiration and relax the smooth muscles of the intestines and non-pregnant uterus. Scientists believe carrot seed extract may prove

valuable in treating mental patients and those with intestinal ailments, as well as relieve some tenseness experienced by pregnant women during parturition, which would be of value in Obstetrics.

In China, the pumpkin is the symbol of fruitfulness and health, and is called the Emperor of the Garden. Pumpkin takes its name from the Greek word "pepon" meaning "Cooked in the sun." The pumpkin seed has been used as a folk remedy for centuries in expelling tapeworms and correcting urinary disorders. According to the seventeenth Edition of the Dispensatory of the United States, 1894, pumpkin seed is one of our most efficient and harmless remedies that expel tapeworms. Pumpkin seeds are also highly valued for their vitalizing effect

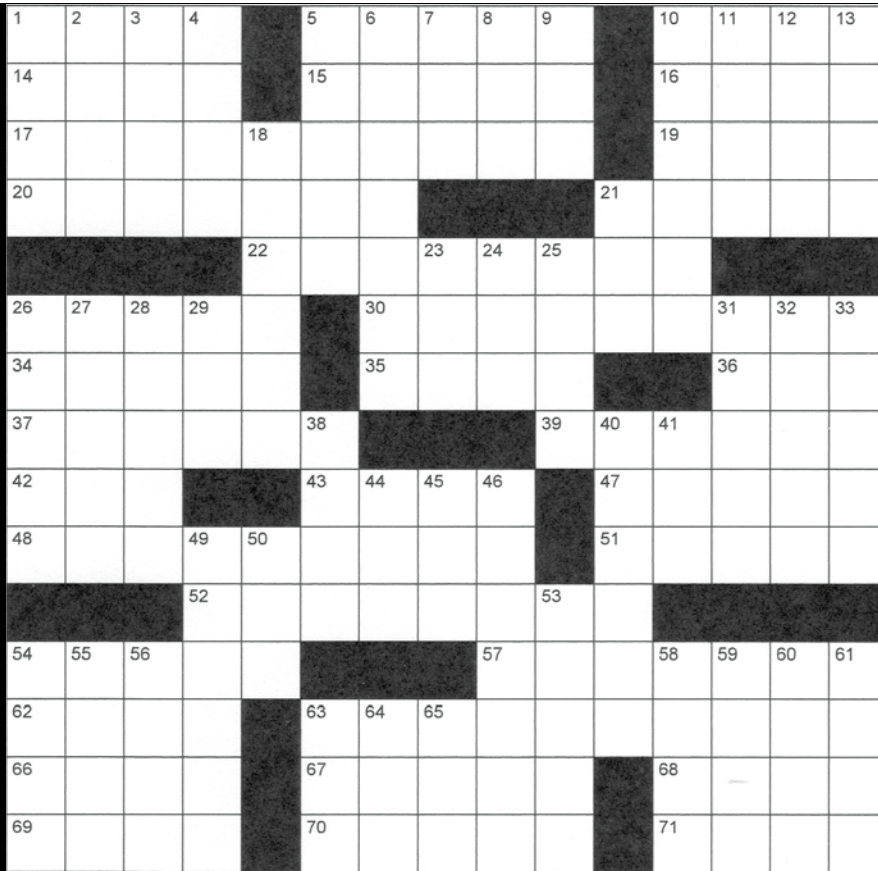

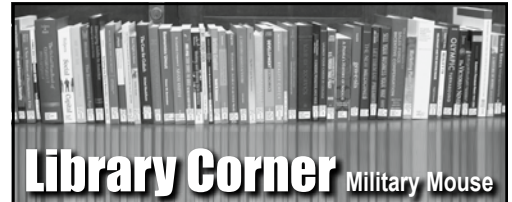

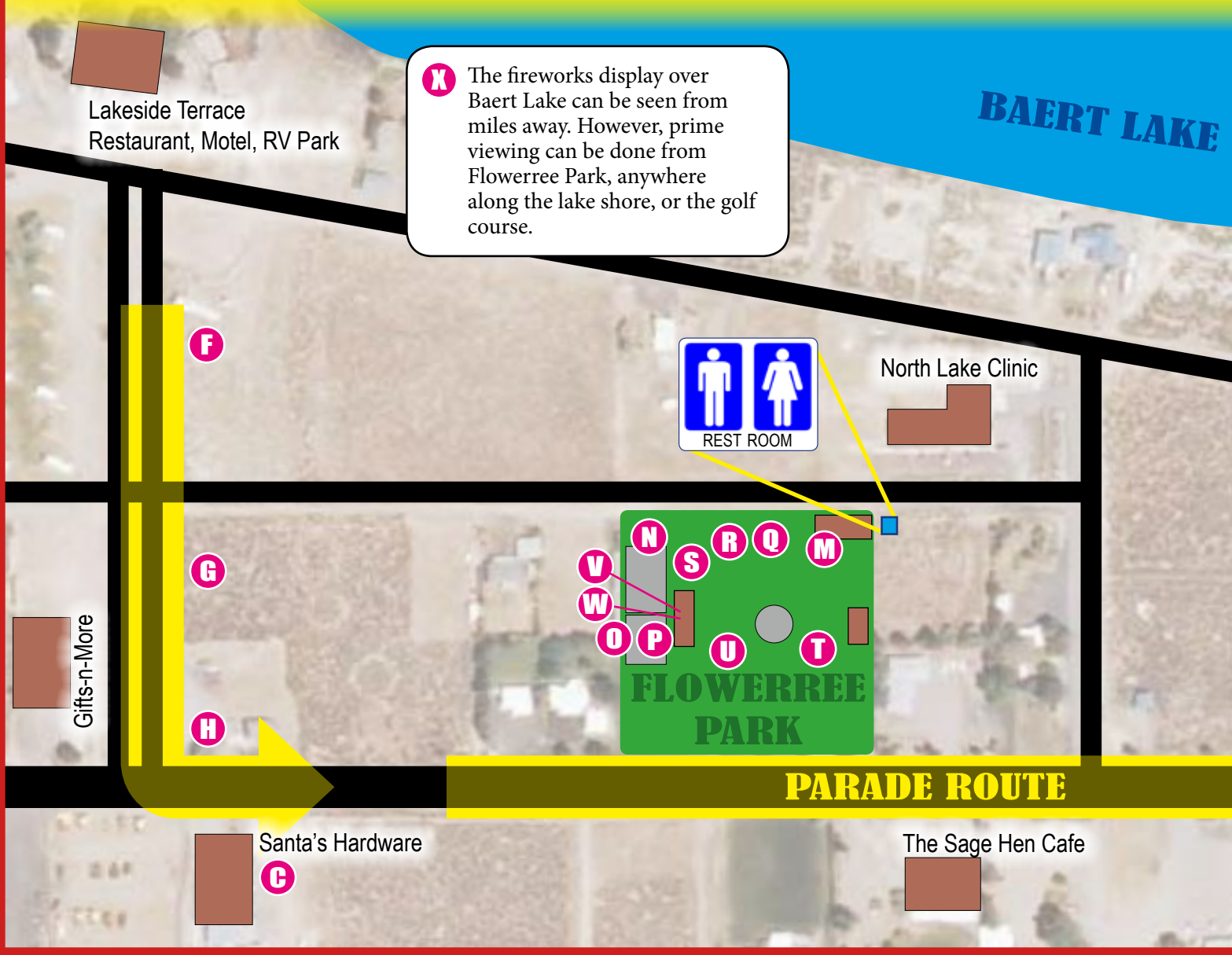

upon the prostate gland. This was a folk remedy handed down from father to son. An article entitled "Androgen-Hormonal Curative Influence of a Neglected Plant" by Dr. W. Devrient of Berlin states the reason the prostate becomes enlarged is due to the organ's efforts to make up for the loss of male hormones that steadily declines with the advance of age. This is similar to menopause in women. It is maintained the number of impotent males in the U.S. amounts to some two million. The poisoning of the glands with tobacco plays a number one important role in impotence. Dr. Devrient feels that prevention is the best course to follow with regard to the problem of prostate trouble. He mentions that in certain countries where pumpkin seeds are consumed in abundance throughout life, there is practically no prostate disorders. He mentions that of the number of substances found in pumpkin seeds, no one knows exactly which it may be that is responsible for the beneficial effects upon the sex organs. Pumpkin seeds have been found to be extremely high in phosphorous, and appear to have a higher content of iron than any other seeds. They also contain an abundance of vitamin B, a small amount of calcium and vitamin A, about 30 percent protein and 40 percent fat, which is rich in unsaturated fatty acid.

Sunflower seeds oil is an excellent source of unsaturated fatty acids and is a

valuable aid in reducing the cholesterol in the blood. They contain an abundance of vitamins and minerals, are rich in vitamin B-complex, and are an excellent source of protein—a high content of phosphorous and calcium makes them a valuable aid in building strong bones and teeth. They also contain carotene, pro-vitamin A, which is necessary for the health of the eyes. They are also very valuable for relief of bronchitis.

Watermelon seeds are used for disorders of the kidneys and urinary passages. They are almost equal in value to pumpkin seeds in the ability to expel tapeworm. Scientists have found a substance present in watermelon seeds that paralyzes tapeworms and roundworms in cats.

Animals freely roaming, with no apparent owner/handler in the area may be treated as strays. The proper authorities will then be contacted.

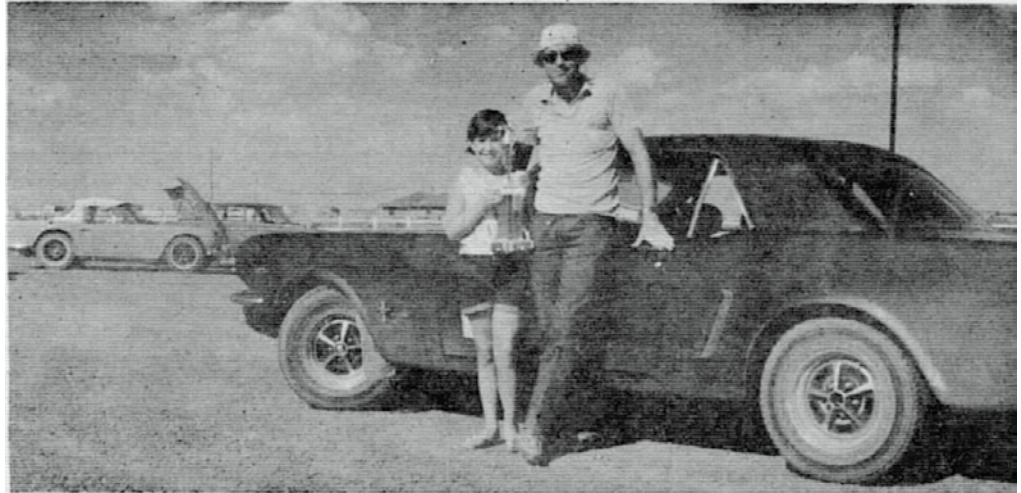
